

Position Description SMRI Chief Corner Marshal

Duties

- Directs corner marshal activities at all race events and track days or designates an alternate to perform these duties.
- Recruits corner marshal personnel
- Briefs corner marshals prior to each event
- Assigns marshals to positions
- Briefs corner marshals on their duties
- Supervises and directs corner marshals during events
- Compensates (or validates novice hours) corner marshals
- Assures corners have necessary equipment in place prior to the beginning of each event
- Replenishes equipment as necessary during the season. (Note: chief corner marshal assures that equipment is available for each event but equipment is distributed and collected by the safety crew)
- Recruits special corner marshal crew for 3-day AHRMA race weekend
- Confers with club officials on general safety issues
- Assists in documenting events pertinent to incidents on track
- Advises club officials on matters related to individual rider conduct

Equipment for each corner includes:

- Fire extinguishers
- Flags appropriate for the particular corner
- Oil dry
- Brooms
- Water and ice
